8,000 killed in Satkhira by Pak Army

SATKHIRA, Jan. 1:—More than 8,000 persons were killed in Satkhira Sub-Division by the Pakistan Army and their collaborators during the last nine months according to a preliminary unofficial survey.

The survey revealed that besides mass killing, a huge number of women were molested by the Pakistan Army and their agents in this sub-division.

A huge number of skulls, bones, and limbs being found every now and then.

The survey further revealed that 50,000 houses, shops

institutions and other business establishment were either burned completely damaged or looted.

Besides, most of the telephone lines bridges and culverts were also destroyed by the Pakistan Army.

The local people are collecting informations from all quarters to prepare a final survey of the damage done by the Pakistan Army and their collaborators during their nine month occupation.
