to go for movements and struggles.

Mrs Choudhry strongly criticised the role of Mr Zulfikar Ali Bhutto and held him responsible for the present state of affairs in the country. She said: "there is no difference between Bhutto and Ayub Khan and accused the PPP chief of conspiring against democracy. She called upon the people of West Pakistan to foil the game of Mr Bhutto.

The President of East Pakistan Students Union (Matia Group), Mr Nurul Islam, and Mr Saifuddin Manik are among others who also spoke at the meeting.

Earlier a public meeting, organised by the Pakistan National League to protest against the postponement of the National

Assembly session was held at the Baital Mukarram.

Mr. Ataur Rahman Khan, President of the Pakistan National League, who presided over the meeting, called for the unity of the people to realise their rights.

Mr. Rahman termed the postponement of the Assembly as an "attempt" to frustrate the framing of a constitution and transfer of power to the people.

He asked the people to remain prepared for "further sacrifices" in achieving their objectives.

Earlier, Shah Azizur Rahman, General Secretary of the party in speech called for coordinated action between the Awami League, NAP (Bhasbani), the Bangla National League and Wail Group of National Awami Party for launching a mass movement to attain their rights. The movement would be to put an end to class exploitation and for establishment of socialism.

The meeting came to an abrupt end following serious interruption of the speech of Mr. Amena Begum, a Vice-President of the Party.—APP.
