

Casualties in Dacca

Dacca (Delayed): Though official figures of the casualties of the last few days are not available, according to the Dacca Medical College Hospital, out of 16 persons admitted on Wednesday, one succumbed to his injuries, while 79 wounded persons were released after first aid.

Dacca Medical College Hospital on Tuesday-Wednesday admitted 125 persons with gunshot injuries of which four people succumbed to their injuries and 40 were still in serious condition in the hospital. During the same period 150 persons, all with gunshot injuries, had been released after first aid. Twelve persons were brought dead to the hospital.

Two persons were killed during curfew hours at a launch on Buriganga river and at Adomjeenagar.

However, the hospital source further said that four more persons with gunshot injuries were brought to the hospital on Thursday morning from the city's old shopping area, namely Nawabpur and Thatarbazar.

Thursday was a peaceful day in Dacca. Except some reported trouble around Nawabpur no untoward incident was reported.
