WEST PAKISTAN ATTACKED AT 7 POINTS

THEY WENT ALL-OUT WAR



PAF BOMBS 7 INDIAN AIRFIELDS INCLUDING AGRA

FROM M. A. MANSURI RAWALPINDI, DEC 3: THE INDIANS HAVE ESCALATED WAR AND EXTENDED THEIR AGGRESSION TO THE WHOLE OF PAKISTAN.

At a hurriedly called Press briefing at about midnight today, a Defence Services spokesman told newsmen that, not satisfied with their aggression in East Pakistan, the Indians have now attacked West Pakistan at seven points at about 12 noon today.

Regular Indian troops moved towards our border posts, manned by Rangers. On being challenged, they opened up with small arms fire, wounding some of our men. The Rangers fired back in self-defence. The Indians subsequently opened up with their artillery.

The spokesman said the Indians have attacked almost simultaneously in Shikargarh salient, Kasur border, Hussainwala headworks, Chann and Rahim Yar Khan, opposite Rajasthan, well inside Punjab.

The Indians also moved into our border posts, manned by Rangers. On being challenged, they opened up with small arms fire, wounding some of our men. The Rangers fired back in self-defence. The Indians subsequently opened up with their artillery.

New escalation by India in E. Wing: PAF in action

RAWALPINDI, Dec 3: Pakistan Air Force (PAF) went into action against the invading Indian troops in East Pakistan twice yesterday.

An official spokesman told newsmen here this evening that, "at about 1530 hours yesterday, Dec. 2, three 'Shahab' attack Indian tanks and several Indian troops in the Akhaura area."

"Our aircraft remained on the ground during the attack," he said and added, "The Indian army opened up with small arms fire, but none of our aircraft was hit."

Replying to questions, he said the Indian tanks and troops attacking the Pakistan Air Force were just as 'Shahab' were well within Pakistan territory. The Indian Air Force did not send its planes to meet.
