WEST PAKISTAN ATTACKED AT 7 POINTS

IT'S NOW ALL-OUT WAR

PAF BOMBS 7 INDIAN AIRFIELDS INCLUDING AGRA

RAWALPINDI, Dec 3: THE INDIANS HAVE ESCALATED WAR AND EXTENDED THEIR AGGRESSION TO THE WHOLE OF PAKISTAN.

At a hurriedly called Press briefing at about midnight today, a Defence Services spokesman told newsmen that, not satisfied with their aggression in East Pakistan, the Indians have now attacked West Pakistan at seven points at about 12 hours.

Regular Indian troops moved towards our border posts, manned by Rangers. On being challenged, they opened up with small arms fire, wounding some of our men. The Rangers fired back in self-defence. The Indians subsequently opened up with their artillery.

The spokesman said the Indians have attacked almost simultaneously in Shakargarh salient, Kasur border, Hussainwala headworks, Chamb and Rahim Yar Khan, opposite Rajastan, well inside Punjab.

The Indians also now have occupied the whole of the Sialkot area. They have also moved into the Dera Ghazi Khan area and are threatening to attack Multan. We must defend ourselves with all our might.

Admiral Munawar Haas said that at midnight the Air Marshal said they had faced the numerical superiority of the enemy before and had proved that our forces alone did not win wars. For the honour of our country, for the defence of our sacred soil, we must sacrifice our might.

In the Navy the Nasirabad base, the Nasirabad base has struck and as far as Muzaffargarh, with full faith in Allah, we will stand by our people. Because we must respond to the call of duty with courage and determination. We must stand together to the enemy, seek out and destroy him wherever he may be.

Any person violating the law and order regulations will be severely punished and is liable to death.

RAWALPINDI, Dec 4: Police tonight stormed a PIA plane held up by two hijackers, and first reports said both had been seized.

One of them was identified as 21-year-old Alphonse Rayon. The man was seriously injured by a pistol blow on the head.

He had been shot in the leg when he attempted to dash through the door to the cockpit.

The plane was held up on the ground with 27 passengers on board as it prepared to leave Lahore for Karachi.—APP.
