MARTIAL LAW ORDERS BY LIEUTENANT GENERAL TIKKA KHAN, S. PK, PSC, MARTIAL LAW ADMINISTRATOR ZONE 'B'

MARTIAL LAW ZONE 'B' ORDER NO. 133

Road blocks or barricades or construction or making of ditches on public High way or roads or rail or runways hampering the movement of vehicles or any other means of transportation is forbidden. Houses or buildings or constructions situated within a radius of 100 yards on either side of such an obstruction shall be liable to be demolished and inhabitants be subject to punitive for causing such obstruction under the provisions of M. L. 25 which prescribes maximum punishment of ten years rigorous Imprisonment.

MARTIAL LAW ORDER BY LIEUTENANT GENERAL TIKKA KHAN, S. PK, PSC, MARTIAL LAW ADMINISTRATOR ZONE 'B'

MARTIAL LAW ZONE 'B' ORDER NO. 134

Whereas the funds of the Awami League, are contribution of the members of the Public; and whereas, it is necessary to ensure that the said funds in East Pakistan are not used or utilised in a manner prejudicial to public interest. Now, therefore, I, Lieutenant General Tikka Khan, Martial Law Administrator Zone 'B' hereby direct that:

a. All transactions of the said fund in East Pakistan shall stand frozen with immediate effect.

b. No person shall, hereinafter, operate the accounts of the said fund except in accordance with the orders issued by me in this behalf, (after an inquiry into the affairs of the said fund has been made under my directions).

c. Banks or firm or concern shall, within three days from the date of issue of this order, surrender the assets and submit to this Headquarters, the accounts of the said fund held by them setting out the details of deposits in and withdrawal from such accounts.
