

# Curfew

In Dacca Curfew is reimposed from 4 p.m. Saturday to 7 a.m. on Sunday. Relaxation is from 7 a.m. to 12 noon.

In Tongi curfew continues till 2 p.m. on Sunday. From 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. relaxation. Continues after 5 p.m.

In Narayanganj curfew continues till 7 a.m. on 29.3.71 (Monday).

According to official announcement anybody seen on the street during curfew hours is liable for action by ML courts.

While ambulances Fire Brigade personnel in vehicles are allowed to move without any curfew pass, the staff and vehicles of the following essential services can move during curfew hours with valid passes issued by ML authority:

- 1 Press
- 2 Water Supply
- 3 Electricity
- 4 Doctors
- 5 Hospital staff

## NORMAL

# MLO 132 on 'Directives' of defunct AL

MARTIAL LAW ZONE 'B'  
ORDER NO. 132

All Government or semi-Government Departments, including banks, or autonomous or semi-autonomous bodies or other functionaries in the Province of East Pakistan, who were directly or indirectly hitherto been complying with the instructions contained in the so called 'Directives' issued by the (defunct) Awami League, shall forthwith cease adhering to the said 'Directives' and return to the normal way of functioning as per the law of the land or procedure prescribed for the functioning of such departments or bodies. Failure to comply with this order shall be punishable under the provisions of MLR-25 which prescribes maximum punishment of ten years R.I.

The Martial Law authority announced on Saturday that Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, chief of the defunct Awami League, had been arrested from his Dhanmondi residence. Dacca on March 25 night.
