

Leaders call on MLA

More political leaders of East Pakistan called on the Martial Law Administrator of Zone B in Dacca on Tuesday and assured him of their full cooperation in the early restoration of complete normalcy throughout the Province, says a Press release issued by the ML authorities in Dacca.
