

Interference condemned

Pir Mohsenuddin

Pir Mohsenuddin Ahmad, President, Jamate-Ulama-Islam, East Pakistan, in a statement issued in Dacca on Wednesday condemned the Indian Government for meddling in the internal affairs of Pakistan and described it as a complete violation of international laws and conventions, reports APP.

Following is the text of the statement by Pir Mohsenuddin Ahmad.

"The Indian news media have been unleashing imaginary and shamelessly false news about the internal affairs of Pakistan for the last few days. They are not feeling the slightest hesitation in carrying out such heinous and false propaganda.

"A resolution has also been adopted in the Indian Parliament on the internal affairs of Pakistan. Besides, there have been reports of concentration of Indian Army along the borders of East Pakistan, infiltration of Indian Army personnel in plain dress with arms and money into East Pakistan, and harassment of Pakistani merchant ship in the high seas.

"By these activities, India is only giving a demonstration of her pre-independence mentality. These Indian activities remind us of repressions of Muslims by the Hindus during the pre-independence days when the Indian Hindus had snatched away all the rights of Muslims through deception under the protection of British rule and compelled the Muslims to lead a sub-human life by causing economic hardships to the Muslims intervening into their religious activities and restricting educational facilities for the Muslim students. So, the Muslims of the then India made a way for leading an honourable life by dividing India to establish their rights, ensure economic progress and restore religious and national freedom.

"But India has not yet been able to forget her old policy. After partition, she has indulged in various conspiracies against Pakistan, such as, refusal to pay the dues to Pakistan and demarcate the borders, attempt to stop supply of river waters to East Pakistan, false propaganda against Pakistan and attempt to snatch away the independence of Pakistan in the darkness of night in 1965.

"This time also India is active to do the same about the internal affairs of Pakistan. Whatever India has done so far is not only heinous and condemnable, it is also a complete violation of international laws and conventions. So, I strongly condemn the Indian activities and want to tell the Indian Government that people of East Pakistan will never fall prey to this Indian conspiracy, rather they will not have the slightest hesitation to sacrifice their lives and properties to foil all sorts of Indian conspiracies. The people of East Pakistan will stand as one-man to preserve their own independence.

"I appeal to my brethren living in the border areas to

of their enemies. They want their rights and it is absolutely their internal matter as to how they will achieve their objectives.

"The leadership of India now stands thoroughly exposed in their design in taking advantage of every situation to achieve their nefarious objectives. We are sure that East Pakistanis will not at all be influenced by Hindu Bharat. Do the Indians think that the people of East Pakistan are so much degenerated that they will consider Bharat as their friend?

"Before allowing the Kashmiris to be free and guaranteeing security to Indian Muslims, Indian leaders must be ashamed of pronouncing any word of sympathy to the citizens of any foreign country.

"By infiltrating armed persons into the soil of Pakistan, Bharat has practically challenged the patriotism of East Pakistanis. The Indians should know that lovers of their motherland can never consider the armed infiltrators of any country as their saviours.

"We strongly believe that the patriotic people of East Pakistan will crush the infiltrators whenever they are found. East Pakistanis can't allow the Indian imperialists to play with sovereignty of Pakistan.

Anjuman-e-Muhajereen

Dewan Warasat Husain Khan, President of the Anjuman-e-Muhajereen, Mashriqi Pakistan has assured President Yahya Khan that the millions of Mohajirs will consider no sacrifice too great for ensuring the safety and integrity of Pakistan, reports APP.

In a statement in Dacca he said that God has saved Pakistan once again. Pakistan was founded on the blood and tears of the martyrs, he added.

He also strongly condemned India's shameless and naked interference into our internal affairs by sending its armed insurgents in East Pakistan to help the secessionist forces here. He appealed to the conscience of the world to raise its voice against such wanton acts of aggression which are a clear and positive negation of all international norms.

He said, the present attitude of India which is backed up by its Goebbellian tactics violates all finer political obligations and seems to be borne out of the frustration it has had as the result of the most timely action by our Armed Forces which foiled its nefarious designs which was nothing but to undo Pakistan through its hirelings and paid agents under the garb of a political movement.

He asked the Indian protagonists of human values as to why they did not shed a drop of tear when their agents and anti-state elements here had let loose a virtual hell against a section of innocent and peace-loving citizens right in March last up to time the belt was tightened around the criminals by the Army, and when thousands and thousands of unwary people were massacred for days together for no obvi-

meddling in Pakistan's internal affairs should not forget their own past record.

The resolution asked as to why no notices had been taken of the atrocities perpetrated by India on the Nagas, the Mizos and the Khasimis and the bloodshed in communal riots in Bharat.

It said the people of Pakistan would not sit silent in the face of interference in Pakistan's internal affairs aimed at damaging country's integrity.

India, the resolution said, was being backed by "imperialists" in its sinister designs against Pakistan's solidarity.

Another resolution passed by the meeting criticised those who had supported Sheikh Mujibur Behman and talked of launching movement in his favour in West Pakistan, but were now pushing as the greatest of patriots. Proper action should also be proposed against such organisations and their leaders, the resolution demanded.

Wattoo's warning

LAHORE, Apr. 7:—President of the West Pakistan Convention Muslim League Mian Muhammad Yasin Khan Wattoo has appealed to the conscience of the world to take a serious note of the nefarious designs and the aggressive activities of India which might spell disaster for the Indo-Pak subcontinent, reports APP.

In a Press statement Mian Wattoo also appealed to the people of Pakistan to unite in this great hour of peril and demonstrate to the world that Pakistan would not allow itself to be coerced by India's threats, mobilisation of India's armed might on Pakistan's borders, description of armed infiltrations, stoppage of overflights and spread of wild and false canners.

He said his party fully supported the views of President Yahya as had been expressed by him in his reply to the Soviet President's letter that Pakistan would not tolerate interference from any quarter in its internal affairs.

Mian Wattoo said the views of the league were clear on the six-points of the Awami League, it had all along been of the view that they were to jeopardise the integrity of Pakistan.

His party, he added, would not countenance any attempt to undermine the solidarity and stability of Pakistan. He hope that conditions in East Pakistan would soon become normal and the East Pakistanis would be able to play a glorious role in shaping the destiny of Pakistan.

Sounding a note of warning against India's designs, Mian Yasin Wattoo said, India continues to develop a threatening posture against Pakistan's security and integrity. India placed an embargo on PIA flights on a very frivolous pretext as to isolate the western wing from the eastern wing. It was followed by sending armed and unarmed infiltrators in East Pakistan for promoting subversive activities.

In a joint statement Prof. Ghulam Azam, Ameen, Mr. Nuruzzaman, Publicity Secretary and Prof. Ghulam Sarwar, General Secretary Jamaat-e-Islami said it was known to the whole world that India is the only enemy of Pakistan.

They said "every Pakistani possessed of any amount of self-respect as a citizen of a sovereign state must strongly condemn the Indian interference in the internal affairs of Pakistan. It is known to the whole world that India is the only enemy of Pakistan and she never respected any canon of international law or morality in respect of Pakistan. Moreover she always violated her own international commitments regarding Pakistan, Kashmir and Indian Muslims.

"The Parliament of Bharat has recently expressed sympathy towards the people of East Pakistan through an unanimous resolution moved by no less a person than the Prime Minister herself. During last 23-years the people of East Pakistan have the bitter experience of the strange friendship from Bharat in the form of Farakka Barrage, continuous trouble created in all the border areas, forcible occupation of Luxmipur, betrayal regarding Berubari and driving away Bengali Muslim population from Assam, Tripura and Batrigacha enclaves.

"The so-called sympathy showed towards us smells of evil design of Hindu imperialism. The Indian Prime Minister should remember that the Muslims of East Pakistan consider Bharat as their arch enemy and they are not at all ready to be their victims. Indian leaders should know what the people of East Pakistan don't want the sympathy

Agitation in Calcutta condemned

Mr. A. N. M. Pakistan is ours and we shall save her at the cost of our life and maintain the solidarity and integrity of Pakistan.

The statement said "India should remember the unequivocal unity of our people at the time of 1965 War with her. We believe that the people of this country especially in the Eastern wing of Pakistan will never tolerate the naked aggression of India to fulfil their "Akhando Bharat" scheme.

"I therefore, urge upon the people of East Pakistan to stand united against the Indian attitude with firm determination, loyalty, faith, unity and discipline to safeguard the sacred trust of Qaid-e-Azam—the sacred land of Pakistan.

an urge to follow what the President calls "the very, very inviting, but dangerous road, of peace at any price". He reflects that course, saying: "after all of this sacrifice and all of this efforts, right at the time we are winding down the war when the South Vietnamese are achieving the capability of taking care of their own defence. If the United States now were to throw in the towel (quit) and the Communists took over South Vietnam then all over South-East Asia, all over the Pacific, in the Mid-East, in Europe, in the world, the United States would suffer a blow. Moreover, when America's power and position as "the greatest peace-keeping nation in the world today" the President fear that peace itself "would suffer a blow from which it might not recover".
