## Tikka Khan sworn in as Governor

Lieut.-General Tikka Khan, S.Pk., was sworn in as Governor of East Pakistan at Governor's House in Dacca, Friday at a solemn ceremony. The Chief Justice, Dacca High Court Mr. Justice B. A. Siddiky, S.Pk., administered the oath of office, says a handout issued by the Government of East Pakistan.

The ceremony started with Tilawat-e-Quran. As soon as the oath was taken the National flag was broken on the Flag Staff.

The swearing in ceremony was attended by the Judges of the Dacca High Court, members of the diplomatic corps and high civil and military officials.

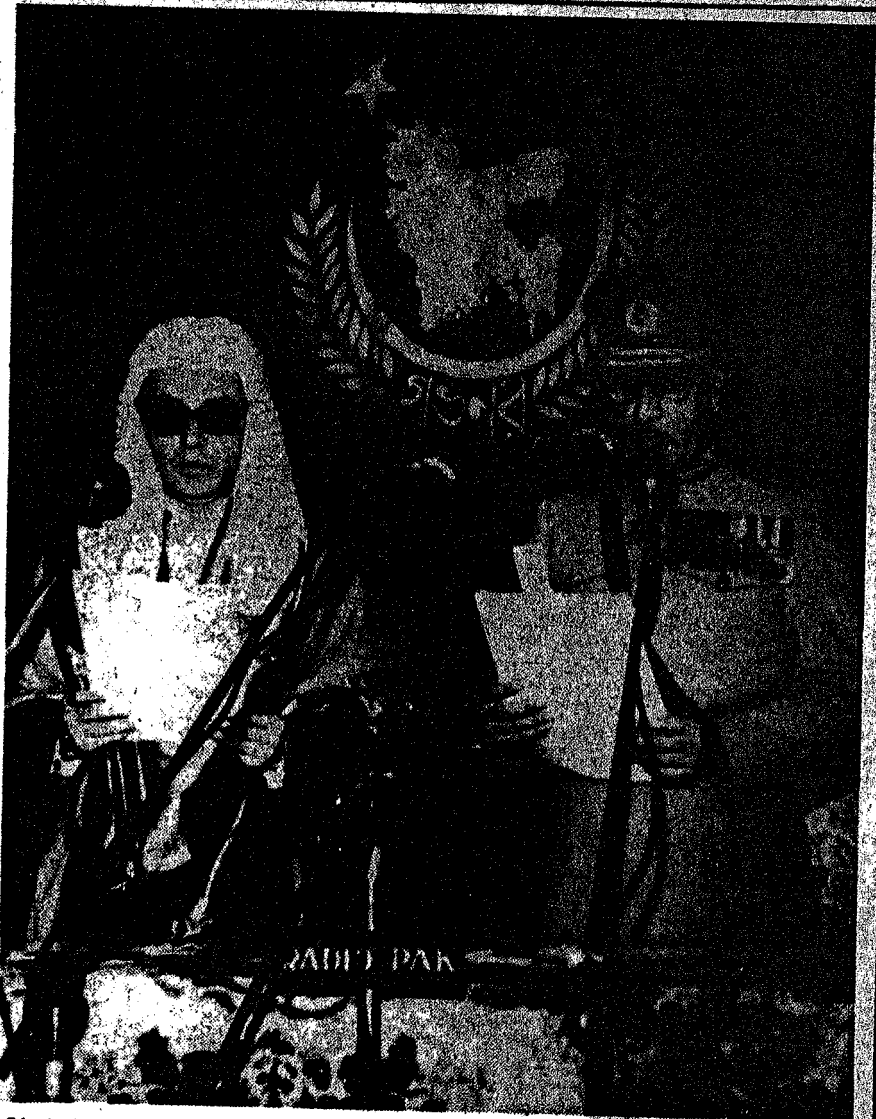
## MLR no 78

RAWALPINDI, Apr. 9.—The President of Pakistan and Chief Martial Law Administrator, General Agha Mohammad Yahya Khan, has promulgated the following Martial Law Regulation here today, says APP.

Martial Law Regulation No. 78—

1. The Chief Martial Law Administrator or a Martial Law Administrator or a Deputy Martial Law Administrator authorised by the Martial Law Administrator concerned in this behalf if satisfied with respect to any particular person, that with a view to preventing him from acting in a seditious manner or in a manner prejudicial to the security, the public safety or interest or the defence of Pakistan the maintenance of public order, Pakistan's relations with any other power, the maintenance of peaceful conditions in any part of Pakistan, the maintenance of essential supplies and services it is necessary to do so, may make an order:

(a) Directing such person to remove himself from Pakistan in such manner by such time and by such route as
