ISLAMABAD, May 13:—To-tal reserves of 14 leading in-dustrial countries rose to the equivalent of dollar 70,424 dustrial countries rose to the equivalent of dollar 70,424 million at the end of the first quarter of 1971, from dollar 56,375 million in the corresponding period last year, according to an I.M.F. report received here today, reports APP.

The reserves in the last quarof 1970 were dollar 65,315 million. These reserves figures comprise holdings of Gold, foreign exchange, special drawmillion. These reserves figures comprise holdings of Gold, foreign exchange, special drawing rights (SDRS—known as paper gold) and reserve positions in the I.M.F. for 13 members of the Fund.

The reserve position in the Fund of 13 industrial member-countries—US. UK, Japan, Austria, Belgium, Ger-Fund of 13 maximum countries—US. UK, Japan, Canada, Austria, Belgium, Denmark, France, West Germany, Italy, the Netherlands, Norway, and Sweden—declined from dollar 6,134 million equivalent at the end of the fourth quarter of 1970, to dollar 5,704 million at the end of first quarter of 1971.
