World Bank team will complete studies in 10 days

KARACHI, May 31—The leader of the eight-man World Bank and International Monetary Fund team, Mr. M. Wiehen left here today for Dacca. report APP & PPI.

Another two members of his team also left along with Mr. Wiehen.

The mission sponsored by the World Bank will start its assessment of the situation in East Pakistan immediately and hopes to complete its studies within ten days, the mission

leader Mr. M. Wiehen, said today.

He apologised to give details to journalists of scope or terms of reference of his team saying, "I have strict instructions not to say anything".

He said, Mr. Peter Cargill, Director of the South East Asia Division, Middle East Department in the International Monetary Fund would be reaching Dacca next week.

Asked if the team would visit places other than Dacca

also, he said, "It is certainly our intention".

He added by saying after about ten days stay in East Pakistan the team would leave for Islamabad and its stay in the capital would depend on circumstances.

Two members of the said team had already arrived yesterday and have reached Dacca.

Another mem'bers will be joining them in a couple of days.
