



Arms, ammunition recovered Many miscreants killed in Khulna

KHULNA, Aug. 8:—A number of miscreants and Indian agents were killed and a huge quantity of arms and ammunition including rifles, mines and explosives were captured by the razakars at different places of the district during the past two weeks.

On the 30th July the razakars of Dacope Police Station fought against a group of armed miscreants and Indian agents who were passing towards Chalna in a boat for sabotage work. In the fight eight miscreants were killed by the razakars and the rest fled away leaving a huge quantity of arms and ammunition including explosives which would have been used for sabotage work in the province.

The razakars of Miksilmlj camp under Dumuria P.S. recently successfully repulsed surprise attack of a gang of

miscreants who later fled away leaving 4 dead bodies and some arms and ammunition. In another attack at Airpur under Batiaghata P.S. the razakars killed three Indian agents and recovered a large quantity of arms and ammunition from them.

The razakars of Phultala P.S. gave a blow to the miscreants and Indian agents who entered the district from across the border of India for destructive work at Phultala Chalna, Mongla, Begerdanga and other places. A huge quantity of arms and ammunition including explosives and mines were also recovered from these Indian agents.

The arms and ammunition so far captured from the miscreants and Indian agents were all of Indian origin bearing marks of Indian Ordnance factories.
