

Six Indian agents killed in Burichang

COMILLA, Sept. 4:—Six Indian agents were killed and two others captured by a patrol party of Mujahids and Razakars in Burichang Police Station the other day according to information available from local Peace Committee reports APP.

It is stated that Mujahids and Razakars on receipt of an information from some patriotic people, rushed to the spot and found some Indian agents engaged in planting dynamite to blow up a bridge near Rajpur under Burichang Police Station. The patrol party attacked the miscreants killing six of them. Two of them were captured. Sufficient quantity of arms, ammunitions and explosives were recovered.

According to another report local patriotic people foiled the attempt of some miscreants to blow up two railway culverts at Shahanzachi Comilla.

It is stated that local inhabitants finding some miscreants engaged in planting something on nearby railway culverts at night, they raised alarm and chased the miscreants, frightened, the miscreants ran for safety leaving behind the explosives unplanted. Local Army unit collected the dynamite from the site.
