

Razakars kill Indian agents

Razakars are effectively dealing with Indian agents in various parts of East Pakistan, according to APP.

A report from Brahmanbaria said that the Razakars mounted a raid on Wednesday night on a hide-out of Indian agents near Manpur, south of Kasba. The raid was organised by the authorities on receipt of information from patriotic citizens. Six Indian agents were killed.

The Razakars also captured from the hide-out one mortar, town sten guns, ten rifles, fifty grenades and one wireless set. They captured documents of military value.

Another report from Jaintiapur (Sylhet) said that Razakars guarding a bridge killed 3 Indian agents who were trying to mine the railway track in the area. The Razakars saw about five persons suspiciously moving on the railway track on Wednesday night. They quietly moved towards them surrounded them and asked their identity. Instead of disclosing their identity, they fired on them. The Razakars immediately took shelter nearby, and suffered no loss. They also opened fire on the saboteurs. Three of them were killed. The remaining saboteurs surrendered themselves to the Razakars.
