Five Indian agents killed by Razakars

The 'Al-Badr' and 'Al-Shams' wings of Razakars killed five Indian agents in Rajshahi, Rangpur and Bogra districts on Wednesday while protecting life of peace-loving citizens as well as means of communication, reports A.P.P.

An 'Al-Shams' party of Razakars while on a night patrol spotted a group of Indian agents trying to plant a dynamite near the Maragram rail bridge in Rajshahi district. Seeing the Razakars, the agents took their positions and tried to offer resistance, but the valour and devotion of Razakars took the better of Indian hirelings and dislodged them immediately. Two Indian agents were killed. The other two took to their heels throwing their rifles in the water. The Razakars recovered the rifles from water and removed the charges placed on the bridge.

In another encounter with the Indian agents at Darajganj in Rangpur, the Razakars killed three Indian agents and recovered two rifles and three shot guns. The encounter took place when Razakars saw Indian agents trying to remove telephone line in the area.

Another report from Rangpur said that 'Al-Shams' group of Razakars unearthed a dump near Barakhata and recovered 150 pounds of explosives, 39 mines and 118 grenades.
