

Minister lauds Razakar's role

SYLHET, Nov. 6:—East Pakistan Minister for Health Mr. Obaidullah Majumder said that yesterday razakars and members of Peace Committee had done tremendous work and rendered yeoman's service towards the restoration of peace and normalcy in the most critical period of the country, reports APP.

The Minister was addressing cross section of people and members of Peace Committee at Gopalganj 14 miles from Sylhet town. He said that the Razakars have been entrusted with heavy responsibility and duty to help the authority restore law and order in the country.

He urged them to keep up the trust reposed in them and they must not do anything which might cause lack of confidence in the people in Government.

The Minister said that Hindustan had been trying to undo Pakistan from its very inception and now she had directed two-pronged attack on Pakistan one by shelling from across the border and the other by sending in the country infiltrators and miscreants to destroy public properties and kill innocent people. But the nefarious design of the enemy would never succeed he observed.

The infiltrators and miscreants had been destroying educational and religious institutions in a systematic way with an avowed object of creating poverty in knowledge and character.

Replying to the address of welcome for setting up a Rural Health Centre at Gopalganj, the Minister said that the country had been passing through the most critical period and as such it was not possible to take up new development project at the moment.

The Minister urged the political leaders to sink their differences and to work together for the cause of Pakistan with a spirit of forget and forgive.
