He had even urged the President to increase their strength and provide them with more arms. The President agreed to his demand and assured him that the number of Razakars would be increased and more arms supplied to them. Mr. Nurul Amin refuted the propaganda against the Razakars that they were killing the innocent people of East Pakis-

tan taking vengeance from the leftist elements or their per-sonal enemies. Had there been some truth in the PPP leaders' allegations against the East Pakistan Razakars President Pakistan Razakars Yahya Khan would increase to strength, nor would Mr. Nurul Amin have pleaded their cause.

The uncontested election of half-a-dozen candidates of the PPP in the National Assembly by-elections has surprised poli-tical circles in Lahore. Though apparently it is the success of Mr. Kasuri's mission, the rightists read something deep into the matter and some of them even describe it a 'cons-They were under the impression that the victory of the PPP of six seats was the result of some understanding Mr. Nurul Amin who the six-party alliance for the purpose of the byelections in East Pakistan. But the ignorance expressed by Mr. Nurul Amin in Karachi and Lahore describing the PPP victory as 'mysterious' con-founded the matter. The matter would not have caused any surprise had the by-elections to most of the vacant N.A. seats been held uncontested because of pre-election understanding among the contesting political parties to which the PPP was not invited. Left to the PPP alone, tt is obvious that it could not win a single seat in East Pakistan because of the grave feelings and sentiments of a majority of the people against the party and its leaders. Then the question arises how it managed to bag six seats?
