

Razakar's pay revised upwards

The pay and emoluments of the Razakars have been revised upwards and brought at par with that of the 'Mujahids' with effect from 1st Dec. '71, says a handout of the Directorate of Razakars, Govt. of East Pakistan, reports APP.

This has been done in view of the active service that Razakars have to perform on the same basis as Mujahids for the defence of the country with prevailing conditions in the province. The Razakars will now be entitled to free rations as authorised for the Army and Mujahids. Under the existing conditions of service the Razakars are not entitled to free rations and have to make their own arrangements for food.
