## Rahman's Step Follows Army Crackdown CIVIL WAR ERUPTS IN EAST PAKISTAN

## Awami League Leaders Go Underground

PAKISTAN'S EASTERN WING, RECHRISTENED THE INDEPENDENT STATE OF BANGLA DESH SHEIKH MUJIBUR RAHMAN IN A CLANDESTINE RADIO BROADCAST, WAS IN THE THROES OF A CIVIL WAR ON FRIDAY WITH WEST WING TROOPS RESORTING TO FORCE TO CONTROL AND THE PEOPLE, AIDED BY THE EAST PAKISTAN RIPLES AND THE POLICE, RESIST-ING THE ATTEMPT, REPORTS UNI.

TEAVY FIGHTING WAS GOING ON IN DACCA, CHITTAGONG, SYLHET, COMILLA AND OTHER ACCORDING TO REPORTS FROM ACROSS THE BORDER GATHERED BY UNI BUREAUS IN SHILLONG AND CALCUTTA AND CORRESPONDENTS CLOSE TO THE BORDER IN THE EASTERN SECTOR. CASUALTIES WERE BELIEVED TO BE HEAVY.

## EMISSARY SENT TO SEEK AID

SHILLONG, Mar 26.—An emissary of Bangla Desh had heen sent abroad to seek the help of "foreign Powers", Swa-dhin Bangla Betar Kendra reported tonight, says UNI.

Without mentioning the name of the emissary, the mode of his transport from troubled East wing and the names of the foreign Powers, the Betar Kendra ap-pealed to "everyone" to help the pause of Bangla Desh.

Speaking over "Swadhin Bangla" (Free Bengal) Betar Kendra, Mr Rahman later proclaimed the birth of an independent Bangla Desh.

The declaration was made short. ly before General Yahya Khan went on the air in the West wing to announce that the army had been instructed to reassert the Government's authority in the East wing. He called Mr Rahman and his followers traitors.
