President Khandaker Moshtaque Ahmed has promulgated Martial Law Regulations providing for penalty of death or transportation for life, rigorous imprisonment, fine and confiscation of property for offences such as corruption, criminal misconduct, illegal possession of arms and ammunition and illegally acquired properties, reports BSS.
